# VET-MEDLINK 2010

Vet-Medlink will run from **Saturday 18th December to Tuesday 21st December 2010**. In addition to Vet-Medlink delegates may attend **Pathology and Parasitology**. The **Pathology and Parasitology** programme will run from **Friday 17th December to Saturday 18th December 2010**. The **Edge** session is open to all attending Vet-Medlink and will be held on the final afternoon. The conference will be held at the **University of Nottingham Main Campus and Jubilee Campus**. Accommodation will be in University halls. Transport between campuses will be provided free of charge. *If you require accommodation either side of the conference please contact us directly on 01509 233133 / 235879 to check availability.*

**Fees (all prices are subject to VAT at the current rate)**  
The fee for **Vet-Medlink** is just **£43** per day (**total £172.13 plus VAT**) which *includes* bed and breakfast accommodation on the University campus. For **Pathology and Parasitology (optional)** the cost is **£61.49**, or **£25.96** for the online version. Tickets for **The Edge** session (*optional*) may be pre-booked with a further cost of **£8.94** per delegate. The **Premium Experience Package** at £51.06 offers significant savings on **Vetschool** and **VETMED-ic**, full details of which are on our website. Bed and breakfast is included, dinner will cost delegates around **£4.50** with both lunch and dinner costing around **£8** per day. **Applications**  
Please use the enclosed booking form and enclose your fee (cheques payable to "THE WORKSHOP"). The **Vet-Medlink** Booklet, containing conference and registration information, will be available on our website and will be mailed to all delegates from early September. After this time we aim to acknowledge bookings within 4 weeks of receipt. If details have not been received within 14 days of the conference please contact the office immediately, so that duplicate information can be mailed or emailed in good time to make travel arrangements. Please note that places are limited: should all places be filled, fees will be returned in full, but a reserve list will be held in anticipation of late cancellations. Invoices will only be issued to institutions on receipt of a purchase order. Bookings will not be considered confirmed until payment is made and registration details will not be mailed until payment is received. Delegates must be 16 years of age.
